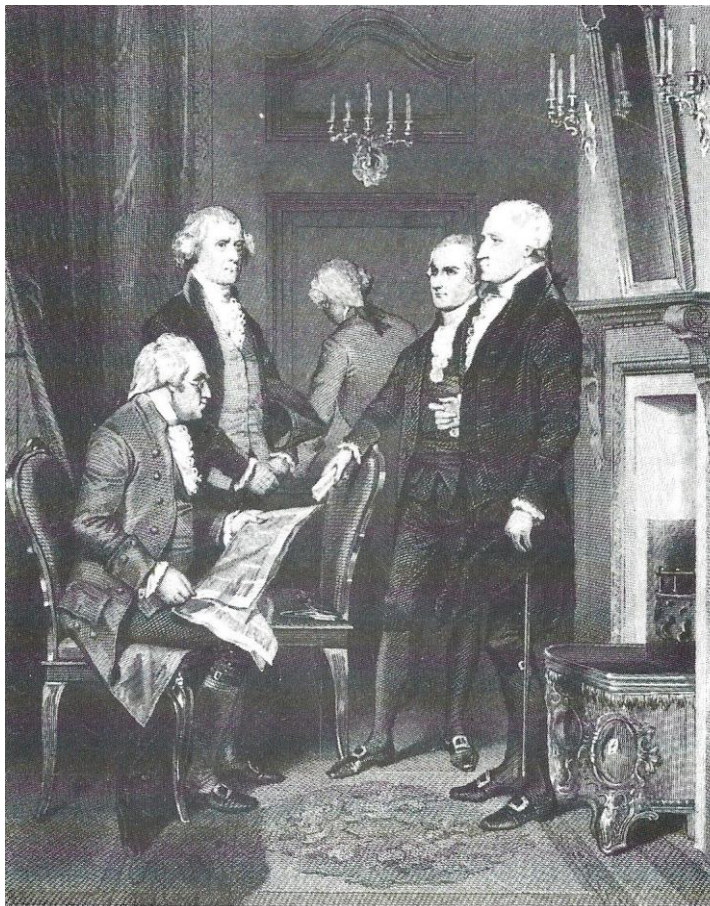

As early as October 1789, Washington consulted heads of Departments on the advisability of his making a tour of the United States. He continued to consult them individually on matters of policy. Meetings of the cabinet occurred in late 1791 and at least three times in 1792. By the time Adams became President, the practice of cabinet meetings was well established.

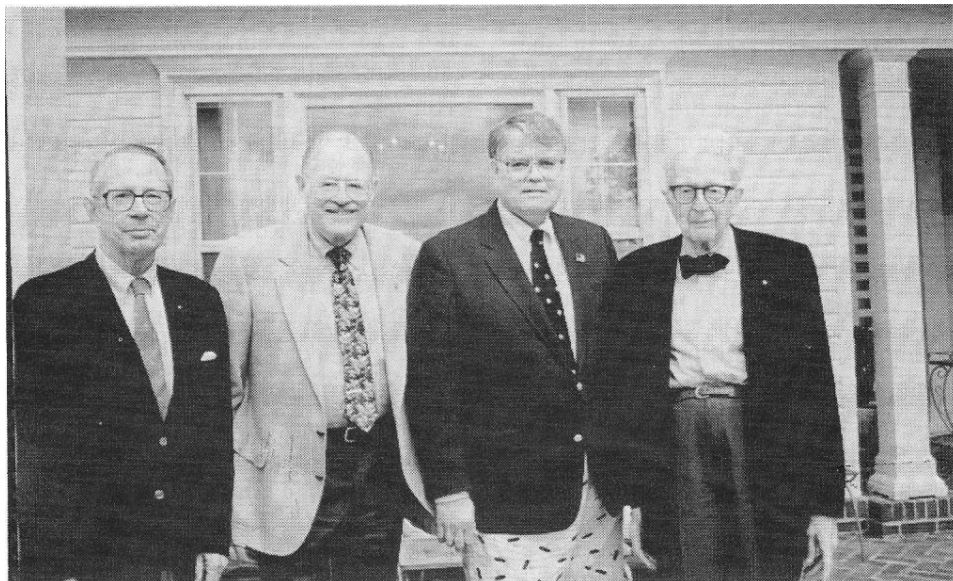

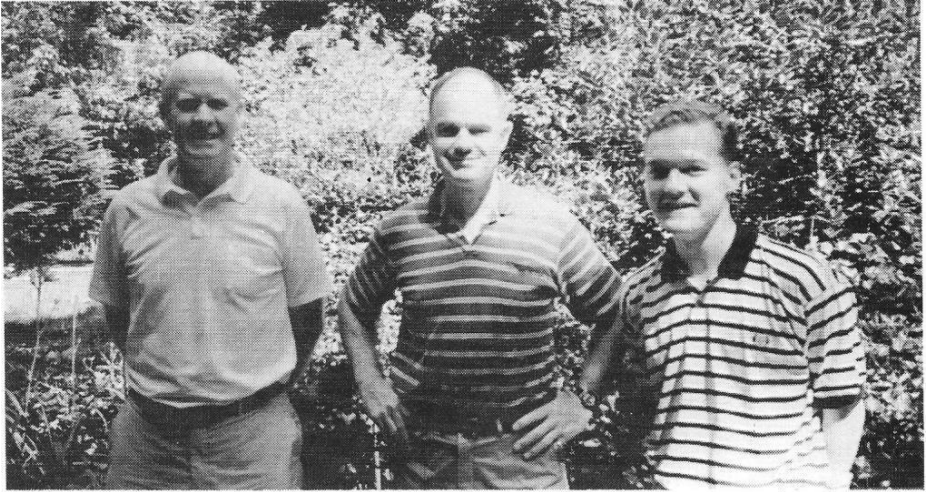

We have scheduled an Anderson House weekend for the 13th to 15th of this September. By the time this C-14 is published the occasion will already be a happy memory.

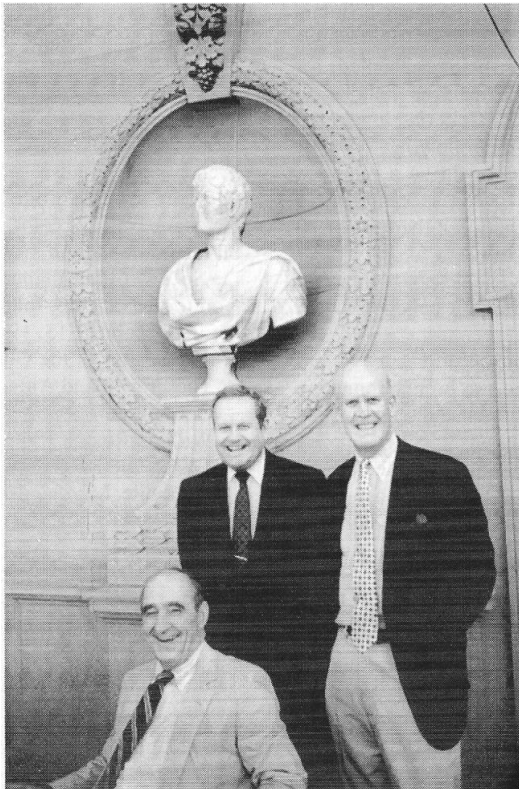
